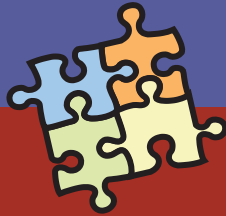

The one-on-one ABA therapy provided in the Learning and Laughter Summer program will focus on increasing language, social skills, motor skills, visual spatial skills, functional skills, early learning and academic skills, reading and writing skills.

#### Learning and Laughter Summer Program activities :

- Circle time, games, music, role play, stories and other structured play activities
- Individual programming "table time" focused on speech-language. This One-on-one individual therapy is used for children who exhibit problem behavior. The focus is on improving language skills, functional and independence skills, motor skills, visual performance, early learning and academic skills, and reading and writing skills. Emphasis is also placed on the development of social skills throughout all summer program activities
- All individual programming is based on a full individual VBMAP assessment completed with your child at the time of intake
- Sensory & gross-motor development through indoor play equipment, strengthening exercises, vestibular input, and sensory integration play and activities.
- Music activities including following directions, language development, and social development through singing, instruments, gestures and imaginative play
- Strategic social interaction to improve social deficits
- Children are grouped by age and developmental level for all activities
- Toileting/diapering, hand washing, snack time
